



WORK STUDY AT THE INSTITUTE

Work-study to reduce fees is available to all participants. It is a fun way to meet others attending and is a vital aspect to the community life of the Institute. Work hours are scheduled around your courses and will include at least one weekend shift. The work-study program is an integral part of the community life of the Institute. Please be prepared to arrive by 2 pm on Saturday for orientation and beginning your work-study. If you are attending the last week of our session, you may need to work Saturday morning July 24.

Work-Study is needed in the following areas:

Kitchen: To help prepare and set-up and clean-up meals

Children's Program: Assisting in the children's programs

Bookstore: To help set up, pack, do inventory, and use cash register
